AN ORDINANCE

CREATING THE POSITION OF WASTE WATER SUPERINTENDENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hubbard, Ohio, wishes to create the administrative position of Superintendent of the Waste Water Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Hubbard, Trumbull County, Ohio:

SECTION 1: The City Council of the City of Hubbard, Ohio, hereby creates the position of Superintendent of Waste Water. This position shall report to, and be under the authority of, the Service Director. This position is a management, non-bargaining unit position.

SECTION 2: The salary of the Superintendent of Waste Water shall be sixty-thousand dollars per year (\$60,000.00 per year). Said employee must maintain all valid licenses required by the City of Hubbard, Ohio; Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio-EPA) ; and any and all other such licenses which might be required by State or Federal agencies.

SECTION 3: The Superintendent of Waste Water, shall be entitled to and granted participation in the Ohio Public Employees Retirement System, be entitled to two (2) weeks paid vacation upon hiring, and hospitalization benefits as granted to AFSCME bargaining unit employees. The Superintendent of Waste Water shall be entitled to compensatory time as per the AFSCME bargaining unit agreement. All compensatory time must be used by year-end or otherwise forfeited. All compensatory time must be approved by the Service Director and subsequently reported to the Auditor's Office for record keeping purposes. The Superintendent of Waste Water shall accrue sick leave as provided by Ohio Revised Code for Ohio public employees. This position is excluded from participation in the Early Retirement Incentive program afforded to the AFSCME bargaining unit members.

SECTION 4: All prior Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: All formal actions of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Ordinance, and all deliberations of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio and any of its committees leading to such action, were in meeting open to the public as required by law.

S SECTION 6: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the City of Hubbard, Ohio by virtue of the fact that supervision and a licensed professional is essential for the Waste Water Department to ensure effective and compliant operation, and as such, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, or in the alternative, from and after the earliest time permitted by law.


