A RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF CONTROL TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE CRACK SEALING OF US62/SR7 WITHIN THE CITY OF HUBBARD, OHIO, WITH ODOT ASSUMING 100% OF THE TOTAL COST, ODOT PID NO. 106317, D04-CS-FY2019.

WHEREAS, The City of Hubbard, Trumbull County, Ohio and Ohio State Director of Transportation have identified the need for the described project:

Crack sealing of US 62/SR 7 within the city of Hubbard.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUBBARD, TRUMBULL COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Being in the public interest, the City of Hubbard gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

SECTION 2: The City of Hubbard shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The State shall assume and bear 100% of all of the costs of the improvement.

The City of Hubbard further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost of those features requested by the City of Hubbard which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.

The City of Hubbard agrees that all right-of-way required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The City of Hubbard also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

SECTION 3: Upon completion of the described Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the City of Hubbard shall (1) provide adequate maintenance for the described Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, 23 USC 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

SECTION 4: The Hubbard Service Director of said City of Hubbard is hereby empowered on behalf of the City of Hubbard to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation which is necessary to complete the above described project.

SECTION 5: All prior legislation or parts thereof in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: All formal actions of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Resolution, and all deliberations of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio and any of its committees leading to such action, were in meetings open to the public as required by law.
