AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY TREASURER TO OPEN A NON-INTEREST BEARING FIRST NATIONAL BANK CHECKING ACCOUNT ENTITLED *CARES ACT ACCOUNT*.

WHEREAS, In accordance with an Auditor of State audit recommendation, it has been deemed essential to have City Council authorize opening any new bank accounts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Hubbard, Trumbull County, Ohio:

SECTION 1: The City Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to open a new non-interest bearing checking account entitled *CARES Act Account*.

SECTION 2: This account shall be used to the purpose of receiving and expending Federal CARES Act dollars related to the City's Covid-19 mitigation activities.

SECTION 3: All prior Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: All formal actions of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Ordinance, and all deliberations of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio and any of its committees leading to such action, were in meeting open to the public as required by law.
