AN ORDINANCE

**AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF CONTROL TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH RUDZIK EXCAVATING INC. FOR THE GRANDVIEW AVENUE CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Hubbard, Ohio, deems it necessary to replace the existing culvert beneath Grandview Avenue due to its deteriorated condition; and

WHEREAS, Grandview Avenue Culvert Project was advertised and bid pursuant to law, and

WHEREAS, further delays with the culvert replacement will most likely cause irreparable damage to the adjacent property and streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Hubbard, Trumbull County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Board of Control of the City of Hubbard, Ohio, be and hereby is authorized to enter into an agreement and contract with Rudzik Excavating Inc. accepting the bid in the amount of \$277,942.00 for the completion of the Grandview Avenue Culvert Replacement in accordance with the plans and specifications as prepared by MS Consultants and the City Engineer's Office.

SECTION 2: The City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to encumber all necessary funds in the appropriate funds, #413 OPWC Capital Project Fund- Grandview Culvert \$192,000.00; and #790 Stormwater Fund \$87,000.00.

SECTION 3: All prior Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the City of Hubbard, Ohio by virtue of the fact that there exists a need to preserve the public property of the City of Hubbard, Ohio, and further delays in repairing the affected culvert will cause irreparable damage to said adjacent property and as such, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, or in the alternative, from and after the earliest time permitted by law.

SECTION 5: All formal actions of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Ordinance, and all deliberations of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio and any of its committees leading to such action, were in meetings open to the public as required by law.
