ORDINANCE NO. 9-22

PASSED June 6 20 22

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE CO-NAMING OF JACKSON STREET FROM WEST LIBERTY STREET TO WEST PARK AVENUE FOR CEREMONIAL PURPOSES AS "CORPORAL RICHARD CHOPPA MEMORIAL WAY".

WHEREAS, the City of Hubbard, has been approached by the Hubbard VFW to honor Corporal Richard Choppa for his service in the Vietnam War; and

WHEREAS, Corporal Richard Choppa was awarded the Order of the Purple Hear, and the Silver Star posthumously for acts of bravery during the Vietnam War; and

WHEREAS, Corporal Richard Choppa resided on Jackson Street prior to his service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Hubbard, Trumbull County, Ohio:

SECTION 1: Jackson Street shall be co-named for ceremonial purposes "Corporal Richard Choppa Memorial Way" from West Liberty Street to West Park Avenue in honor of the sacrifice of Corporal Richard Choppa in service to his country.

SECTION 2: All prior Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: All formal actions of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Ordinance, and all deliberations of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio and any of its committees leading to such action, were in meeting open to the public as required by law.
