AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO A WATER SUPPLY REVOLVING LOAN ACCOUNT (WSRLA) AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF HUBBARD FOR THE 2022 LEAD SERVICE LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hubbard seek to replace existing lead service lines in the water distribution system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hubbard has previously received a grant of \$180,000 through the H₂O₂ program for the replacement of lead service lines under the 2022 Lead Service Line Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hubbard intends to apply for WSRLA funding through the Ohio EPA to serve as an additional funding source for the construction of the 2022 Lead Service Line Replacement Project in the event that the grant provided by H₂O₂ is exceeded; and

WHEREAS, the replacement of lead service lines is eligible for principal forgiveness of the WSRLA loan through the Ohio EPA; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio EPA WSRLA requires the government authority to pass legislation for application of a loan and the execution of an agreement as well as designating a dedicated repayment source in the event principal forgiveness is not obtained.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUBBARD, OHIO:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for and enter into a WSRLA agreement with the Ohio EPA and Ohio Water Development Authority for the replacement of lead service lines on behalf of the City of Hubbard, Ohio.

SECTION 2: The City of Hubbard desires to request a WSRLA loan in an amount not to exceed \$225,000 with the intention of requesting principal forgiveness as the funding will be solely used for the replacement of lead service lines.

SECTION 3: The dedicated source of repayment will be water user fees if not granted principal forgiveness by the Ohio EPA.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City for the reason that the OEPA application must be executed at the earliest possible date; therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 5: All prior Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: All formal actions of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Ordinance, and all deliberations of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio and any of its committees leading to such action, were in meeting open to the public as required by law.
