AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF CONTROL TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MS CONSULTANTS, INC., CONTINGENT UPON RECEIVING OHIO EPA WATER SUPPLY REVOLVING LOAN ACCOUNT (WSRLA) FUNDING FOR THE 2023 WATERLINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hubbard, Ohio deems it necessary to replace the existing waterlines on Caroline and Rebecca Avenues between Myron Street and West Liberty Street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hubbard requested qualifications pursuant to law in December 2022 from consulting engineering firms for General Engineering services, of which waterline improvements were included, and selected ms consultants, inc. as the highest ranked firm; and

WHEREAS, ms consultants, inc. has submitted a proposal to provide comprehensive engineering services in two individual Task Orders; and

WHEREAS, Task Order #1 includes field survey, design, and bidding services, and Task Order #2 includes construction, administration, and inspection services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hubbard is in the process of obtaining a loan through the Ohio EPA Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA) to finance the required engineering.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Hubbard, Trumbull County, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Board of Control of the City of Hubbard, Ohio is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with ms consultants, inc., for Task Order #1, and Task Order #2 in the amount of \$140,917.00 for the engineering services as outlined above for the 2023 Waterline Replacement Project.

SECTION 2: Execution of the agreement with ms consultants, inc. is contingent upon receiving satisfactory funding through the Ohio EPA Water Supply Revolving Loan Account.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the City of Hubbard, Ohio by virtue of the fact that these waterlines are needed in the most timely of fashions in order to maintain a safe water distribution system, and as such, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, or in the alternative, from and after the earliest time permitted by law.

SECTION 4: All prior Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: All formal actions of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Ordinance, and all deliberations of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio and any of its committees leading to such action, were in meeting open to the public as required by law.
