AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF CONTROL TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH UTILITY CONTRACTING INC., CONTINGENT UPON RECEIVING OHIO EPA WATER SUPPLY REVOLVING LOAN ACCOUNT FUNDING, FOR THE 2023 WATERLINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hubbard, Ohio, desires to replace the existing 6" waterlines on Caroline and Rebecca Avenue with new 6" waterlines; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 Waterline Replacement Project was advertised and bid pursuant to law, and

WHEREAS, the City of Hubbard intends to utilize American Rescue Plan Act funding to fund a portion of the project, and

WHEREAS, the City of Hubbard is also in the process of obtaining a loan through the Ohio EPA Water Supply Revolving Loan Account to fund the remainder of the cost of the improvements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Hubbard, Trumbull County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Board of Control of the City of Hubbard, Ohio be and hereby is authorized to enter into an agreement and contract with Utility Contracting Inc., accepting the bid in the amount of \$1,193,355.00 for the completion of the 2023 Waterline Replacement Project in accordance with the specifications as prepared by ms consultants and the City Engineer's office.

SECTION 2: Acceptance of the bid and execution of the agreement and contract with Utility Contracting Inc. is contingent upon receiving satisfactory funding through the Ohio EPA Water Supply Revolving Loan Account.

SECTION 3: All prior Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the City of Hubbard, Ohio by virtue of the fact that there exists a need to preserve the public property of the City of Hubbard, Ohio and as such, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, or in the alternative, from and after the earliest time permitted by law.

SECTION 5: All formal actions of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio relating to the adoption of this Ordinance, and all deliberations of the City Council of Hubbard, Ohio and any of its committees leading to such action, were in meetings open to the republic as required by law.
